Law Enforcement and Violence Prevention

District Attorney Pamela Price, who took office in January 2023, will speak to PANIL neighbors about what are and are not the responsibilities of the Alameda County Office of the District Attorney. She will review the policies she is following and describe initiatives the Office is working on.

Rocky Hunt of CURYJ (pronounced “courage”) will talk about restorative justice, what it is and how it works. CURYJ (<https://curyj.org/>) is the violence prevention and interruption program with activities primarily in the Fruitvale neighborhood with youth returning from the juvenile justice system. Their work is aimed at ending mass incarceration and youth criminalization.

For this PANIL meeting, you must register in advance.
